Statement of Resignation of Registered Agent Form RA-6 Ver. 3, April 2018.

This form is for registered agent to resign from the represented entity.

A statement of resignation shall be effective on the earlier of the 31st day after the day on which it is delivered for filing or the appointment of a new registered agent for the represented entity.

A registered agent promptly shall furnish the represented entity notice in a record of the date on which a statement of resignation was delivered for filing.

When a statement of resignation takes effect, the registered agent shall cease to have responsibility for any matter tendered to it as agent for the represented entity. The resignation shall not affect any contractual rights the entity has against the agent or that the agent has against the entity.

A registered agent may resign with respect to a represented entity whether or not the entity is in good standing.

Under the provisions of the Title 29 of D.C. Code (Business Organizations Act), the following commercial and noncommercial registered agent is resigning as the registered agent for a represented entity and for that purpose submits the statement below.

- 1. Name of the Domestic or Foreign Filing Entity.
- Name of the Current Registered Agent.
- 3. The agent resigns from serving as agent for service of process for the entity.
- 4. The address of the entity to which the agent will send the notice required by law.

If you sign this form you agree that anyone who makes a false statement can be punished by criminal penalties of a fine up to \$1000, imprisonment up to 180 days, or both, under DCOC § 22-2405;
